<p>NOTES (Numbers refer to sections above) You must have your banns read out in church for three Sundays during the three months before the wedding. This is often done over three consecutive Sundays. At least seven days notice is required before the first reading of banns. (2) If either of you will not be 18 by the proposed date of the wedding, the priest will need to know whether the consent of parents or guardians has been obtained. (4) Make sure you include the name of the town, county, and postcode. (7) This means the Church of England parish in which you live (You can check which parish you live in by going to www.acny.co.uk).
