WE ARE COVID-19 SECURE

What should I be aware of before I arrive?

As you can imagine, there are quite a few changes, here are the main ones to be aware of

- Please wait to be let in by your group leader, if a queue forms please queue along the windows of the hall whilst observing physical distancing
- There is a One Way System in operation - you should enter through the usual front door and exit through the fire escape into the car park - if you are collecting a young person you should wait by the ramp in the car park whilst maintaining physical distancing
- Hand sanitiser on entry and exit is required - hand washing facilities are also available in the toilets
- Face masks are mandatory inside the building unless you have a valid medical exemption, you are a member of staff or your activity allows for the removal of as mask during the activity
- The capacity for the whole building is 30, although this may be less depending on your activity
- The maximum people allowed in the lobby at any one time is 3 and you should avoid lingering or waiting there
- 2 metre Physical distancing should be observed between households whilst in the Church Hall - unless your activity required a larger distance, please follow the guidance from your group leader
- Only one person allowed in each toilet
- The Kitchen is closed - bring your own refreshments
- The Stage is closed and out of use for the time being
- The Howe Room is closed
- There is no access from the Main Hall to the Howe Room, Office, Stage or toilet at that end of the building as this is kept as a safe area for our Staff - please respect this
- There is no access to the office at the moment and all contact should be done by phone, email or post - this is to protect our staff and keep a safe working environment for them
